### SALINA AREA TECHNICAL COLLEGE

Students are enrolling for Salina Area Technical College concurrent courses this month for the fall semester. Students must have their social security number to apply to the college. Tuition this year is \$95 per credit hour for pre-college rates, but the welding and accounting courses are paid for by the state of Kansas. If needed, you can make payment arrangements with SATC. Students who are taking college credit for the first time are eligible for the [Earl Bane Micro-Scholarship](#) at \$250 each. Keep on the lookout for that announcement coming soon. *Spring enrollment will begin in December or January.*

### CREDIT RECOVERY
